Christ Episcopal Church in Cooperstown, NY, will be the setting for a remarkable musical concert. The occasion will honor Holy Trinity Orthodox Seminary, the well-known educational institution of the Orthodox Church marking 75 years since its founding in nearby Jordanville, NY (1948).

Echoing the historical origins of HTOS will be a broad range of talent and musical sound. Selections from Russian, Ukrainian, and related artistic traditions will comprise a program ranging from the ancient monody of early Slavic chant to the lustrous keyboard technique of contemporary Russian composers and pianists. This evening will unfold in three parts:

Osanna Chamber Ensemble—the critically acclaimed group from New York City presenting some of the most celebrated selections of modern-day Orthodox Christian sacred choral singing.

Timothy Morrow—a stunning pianist and composer whose mastery of the keyboard is

so revealing of the fathomless 'inner world' that a young American musician can acquire from the study of Russian piano literature.

The Seminary Choir from Jordanville—is one of today's active exponents of the sonorous choral practice maintained at all church services in Holy Trinity Monastery, Jordanville.

Traditional Russian bell ringing as recorded in Jordanville's bell tower will introduce the evening's musical experience.

Ticket sales will begin on April 1 and will be available on a first come first served basis for up to one hundred and fifty attendees.
